

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The first article of this series on the Sacred Hebrew Alefbayt (AB) was written for the Fall 2013 Quarterly. This means that this series of articles on the letters alone has traversed approximately six years of exploration, reflection, and consideration. If the articles on the Sacred Numbers as Archetypes are also included, this complete project has spanned a period of nearly nine years. The symbolism is apt; whether considering the archetype of the Ennead or the ninth letter of the Ancient Hebrew (AH) alphabet, Tayt, both have themes of climax and completion. This article, then, seeks to summarize and synthesize the information explored and discovered throughout this spiritual sojourn.

The second introductory article of this series provided a large chart which summarized key information and critical assumptions (e.g., astrological correspondences) made at the onset of this project. For convenience and to encourage reflection and juxtaposition, I am reprinting it below, with a row added below each entry which includes **Keywords and Essential Descriptions**, based on both General (G) and Phonoseman-

LUCK. Those energies represented by any trine happen naturally and are true gifts but are not always "givens". Any trine in any chart is just that by itself: a gift. We didn't work for it, that we remember; we see where it is in our horoscope, and we just trust that whatever circumstances which are associated with that trine will come out at least okay, and often with good fortune. But astrological luck can be fickle. Any trine must be nurtured to live up to its Luck. Most planets involved in trines have other aspects which may be stronger and demand more attention, so our trines must be developed and given muscle in order to work their magic for us.

So, all that being true for a simple trine, has got to be TRUE x 3 or more for a Grand Trine. This equilateral triangle has been called the Cosmic Gift. Think about that in relationship to our spiritual journey; for that is after all what we are considering today! A Grand Trine which is not developed may turn completely and bring self-destruction. Consider again friend Paul, who ultimately lived his charmed life taking advantage of others' good will without any intention of reciprocity. Without work, the Grand Trine's energy becomes the opposite of luck and invites disaster. Life for friend Paul was always just too easy. As he used up one set of friends, one town, one relationship; there was another to be found in another place. He had not developed selfdiscipline as a young person; and as he aged, he found his adversities growing and had no way to face his problems, which were all inside jobs. Ultimately, he allegedly killed a lover in a very sordid situation, who was the son of an influential foreign diplomat. Paul was incarcerated awaiting trial. The evidence was against him. He pleaded with his aged parents for help, so they mortgaged their home and sold any possessions of value to stand his bail. On the first day of the trial he never appeared and has not yet been found. His parents were ruined and died bankrupt physically and emotionally, saying to the end: "He was such a beautiful child."

What I witnessed through the years was a steady decline of any spirituality in Paul. He became hardened, selfish, pedantic, and honestly not anyone that any of his old friends wanted to know. I recall at that time really understanding that a Grand Trine is a triple edged sword if not nurtured and worked, especially as a spiritual tool. People who have Grand Trines can develop into wonderful healers, amazing inventors, and humanitarians. What I believe to be true, is that the spiritual nature of the Grand Trine lies in the reali-

zation that service to others and selflessness, also known as Contributing Your Utmost to Universal Welfare, are the keys to having the biggest and best LUCK that this aspect has to offer. This may be the secret to the spiritual gifts of this aspect as well.

Now the reality is that not all of us have a natal Grand Trine; however, we will attract one with some certainty during our lives with major, minor, or progressed aspects. We Stellarians are very resourceful when it comes to finding energy for our spiritual progression! Be sure to take advantage of what comes along, and just remember that these travelling aspects all have a one-degree orb of influence. In order to use these progressed energies, we need to be clear about what kinds of work we must do to attract the luck.

The fiery trine brings the gift of Inspiration. Looking at the planets involved, we can take that energy which is shown and use it to inspire others and ourselves for the greater good. The earthen trine gives us Practicality, and the ability to systematically institute changes that will make a difference in the world around us. I can't help but think about how a Grand Trine here might lead to healing for our Mother Earth. The Grand Trine in air allows us to Aspire for the better and more positive in relationship to the planets and houses engaged in the aspect. The watery Grand Trine gives us the Emotion necessary to intuitively know that which might be healed for the good of all. The potential for Spiritual Healing is one of the most valuable uses of the Grand Trine in any element.

To further our knowledge of the Grand Trine, let us apply the same process we have learned in our prior adventures with aspects. Many of us may not have a natal Grand Trine, but be sure to check your current and upcoming progressions in case one is coming along. Believe me when I say that after having researched and written about the possibilities for using the Grand Trine for spiritual work, I will be actively engaged when faced with the experience of having this new energy coming along by major and minor progression.

Let us begin this process by listing any Grand Trines first in the natal horoscope, and then in the progressed chart. For this aspect write in the following information: Planet/ sign/house/element/etc., for each point of the Grand Trine, then also note which planet in the aspect is the strongest, as this will be the point where the aspect will most commonly express itself.

Engage in a specific activity, as in writing, sculpture, collage, drama, and especially exercises in Extension of Consciousness to help see how this might manifest in life and considering how the energies can be used for service to and for others rather than for self. Think of all the many ways to help manifest Universal Welfare using the Grand Trine. Write this down or at least record it in your spiritual journal. Repeat this process for each Grand Trine in the natal and progressed (major, minor, and transiting) horoscopes.

Meditate carefully on the Grand Trine for more ideas as to its usefulness in your spiritual growth through your focus on others as the beneficiaries. In prayer and meditation, remember always that this aspect is truly the greatest gift given to us for our spiritual progress. Let's use it wisely and well, for by advancing others we humble ourselves before Eternal Spirit in whom we live, move, breathe, and have our being.

tic (P) symbolisms discovered through the process of researching and composing these articles.

Importantly, the reader will note that the AH letters are not presented below in sequential order. While there are potential merits to such a presentation, it is the opinion of the author that the pattern presented below specifically, of grouping the letters according to their status as Mother, Double, or Single Letters—is of greater value and import than the straightforward sequential presentation of the AH letters. There are powerful, determinative patterns present in the former style of presentation that can easily be occluded by a simple sequential description of the AH letters. However, there is also value in a sequential description. Hence, while presenting the AH letters according to the former grouping, the interpretations below will at times call on both categories of organization.

Finally, it is the deep and enthusiastic hope of the author that this information will materially contribute to what is known and understood about these several archetypes, especially as relates to the apparent phonosemantic elements of the Sacred Hebrew Alphabet.

General Symbolism (GS) of Aleph: 1st Mother letter and 1st sequential letter of AB; God; Spirit; Unity; Oneness; Chaos, that which is invisible.

Phonosemantic Symbolism (PS) of Aleph: A guttural consonant produced at the 1st articulatory position (i.e., throat). Sound produced deep in the throat, invisibly. As such, symbol of spirit- that which motivates and underpins manifestation but can never be perfectly represented by it.

PS of Mem: A labial consonant produced at the 5th articulatory position (i.e., lips). As its articulation is obvious to the viewer, so also is it symbolic of that which is overt, visible, and material.

PS of Bayt: A labial consonant produced at the 5th articulatory position (i.e., lips). Similarly to Mem, symbolic of that which is overt, visible, and material.

GS of Pay: 5th Double Letter and 17th sequential letter of AB; Process of speech production as a metaphor for creation; Letters of AB as archetypes of building blocks of universe itself.

PS of Pay: A labial consonant produced at the 5th articulatory position. As God used letters (i.e., use of language to delimit thought) to create universe and all within it, God gifts us the ability to follow suit on a smaller scale by using language to formulate and communicate ideas.

PS of Raysh: A dental consonant produced at the 4th articulatory position. At least in one variation, produced through rapid alteration of tongue (i.e., trill). Speed and changeability of Mercury evident in basic formation of phone.

GS of Taw: 7th (**final**) Double Letter and 22nd (final) letter of AB; Symbolic of completion, realization, process of creation brought to fruition; Associated with symbol of cross, which is itself formed through a healthful balance of spirit (circle), mind (vertical line), and body (horizontal line).

PS of Taw: A lingual consonant produced at the 3rd (central) articulatory position. A near-perfect phonetic representation of its meaning (semantics). Three sounds that compose it (namely, /t/, /a/, and /w/) are lingual, guttural, and labial, respectively. Phonosemantically, symbolic of state of harmony and balance between three universal forces of mind, spirit, and matter. AH word "emet", or "truth", formed in a similar fashion, phonetically capturing its semantic intention.

GS of He: Ist Single Letter and 5th sequential letter of AB; Essentially an audible breath, symbolic of life itself, and all of the complexity and grandeur that entails; Self-replication; Life from life, breath from breath; 4 elements under the proper and healthful dominion of mind, or if inverted, lower desires overshadowing reason; Associated with Aries, first sign of zodiac and sign of early spring and new life; Golden Mean (i.e., Phi) as ubiquitous form of adaptable symmetry in living things.

PS of He: A guttural consonant produced at the 1st articulatory position. Through its association with the mother letter Aleph (as a guttural consonant), symbolic of spirit, that which animates and orchestrates life.

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GS of Waw: 2nd Single Letter and 6th sequential letter of AB; for clear and correct phonosemantic analysis, must be considered as **labial**, not dental as in modern pronunciation (i.e., Vav); Symbol of symmetry and physical perfection; 3 dimensions of space produce 6 directions; 1 st perfect number (i.e., 1 + 2 + 3 = 6); also produced by multiplication of factors (i.e., $1 \times 2 \times 3 = 6$); by corollary, also demonstrates arithmetic symmetry subtractively and divisionally.

PS of Waw: A labial consonant produced at the 5th articulatory position. Name of letter itself (i.e., Waw) is perfectly symmetric and balanced; First letter of AB to demonstrate such an overt state of symmetry; Strong correlation between phonetic pronunciation and semantic value.

PS of Zayin: A dental consonant produced at the 4th articulatory position. Yod, symbolic of spirit, lies concealed within letter name; symbolic of spirit as residing in matter.

GS of Chayt: 4th Single Letter and 8th sequential letter of AB; Symbolic of death and re-birth; Octad as completion of one cycle and concomitant beginning of next; Begins AH word for "sin", representative of a metaphoric death, as it takes actor further from God; Also begins AH word for "life", reinforcing dual symbolism of death and rebirth.

PS of Chayt: A guttural consonant produced at the 1st articulatory position. /ch/ sound indicative of dissolution and chaos of death; /y/ represents spark of life that then begins a new cycle (/t/).

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GS of Tayt: 5th Single Letter and 9th sequential letter of AB; through its association with the Ennead, symbolic of climax and completion of process that began with Monad; "Harmony of Harmonies"; "Trinity of Trinities"; Synthesis of 1st (Spiritual) Triad, 2nd (Physical) Triad, and 3rd (Mental) Triad represented by single digits up to and including the Ennead (9).

PS of Tayt: A lingual consonant produced at the 3rd articulatory position; articulatory position of Tayt itself demonstrates balance, as it is the most central of the articulatory positions; Tayt also literally acts as a "Harmony of Harmonies" phonosemantically, in that it is pronounced intermediate to Gimel (3rd sequential letter) and Waw (6th sequential letter), each of which concludes a Triad within the Decad.

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GS of Yod: 6th Single Letter and 10th sequential letter of AB; as first compound letter, symbolic of Multiplicity as Unity; "10" is perfect representation of this concept, as it is comprised of "1", a unity, and "0", an overt symbol of a completed cycle; symbolizes completion of one round of activity and simultaneous introduction of a new level of progression.

PS of Yod: A palatal consonant produced at the 2nd articulatory position; as such, symbolic of bridge between spiritual and mental planes; only AH letter than hangs suspended above the line, indicating movement to a new, higher plane of action.

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GS od Lamed: 7th (central) Single Letter and 12th (central) sequential letter of AB; due to its doubly centralized position and sheer physical size as written, towering over other letters, symbolic of state of centrality, balance, and harmony; same principle reinforced by its Gematria (Lamed = 30; 3 + 0 = 3; $12 \rightarrow 1 + 2 = 3$). Further reinforced still through its association with Libra, the sign that is emblematic of balance.

PS of Lamed: A lingual consonant produced at the 3rd articulatory position; as such, an excellent representation of aforementioned archetypes (i.e., centrality, harmony, balance), as it is formed in most central of five articulatory positions.

GS of Nun: 8th Single Letter and 14th sequential letter of AB; through analysis of its Gematria $(50 \rightarrow 5 + 0 = 5; 14 \rightarrow 1 + 4 = 5)$ symbolic of second iteration of Pentad (5), thus new life, re-birth; as described below more completely, as it is AH letter pronounced at **highest point in vocal tract**, figuratively interpreted as optimism, hope, faith, and inspiration; if we consider system of 22 AH letters as 3 sets of 7, a **Spiritual Heptad (1-7), Material Heptad (8-14), and Mental Heptad (15-21)** arise. The 22nd letter shares a common symbolism with 4 and 10, representing the capstone (i.e., realization or manifestation) of the process originated with the Monad.

PS of Nun: A lingual consonant produced at the 3rd articulatory position. Interestingly, as a nasal consonant, airstream is actually shunted **up** into the nasal cavity and emitted through nose (i.e., no air leaves mouth). For this reason, Nun is AH letter pronounced at **highest point in vocal tract**. As such, figuratively interpreted as optimism, hope, faith, and inspiration.

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GS of Samech: 9th Single Letter and 15th sequential letter of AB; symbol of transformation of mind through overcoming material temptations; relates to Kabbalistic concept of "Satan", which is viewed as an internal, self-serving force that must be overcome in order to grow and develop spiritually; The Great Foe can be vanquished on a moment-to-moment basis, but constant vigilance is necessary, as the desire to serve self runs deep, and may even be described as instinctual.

PS of Samech: A dental consonant produced at the 4th articulatory position. The first letter of Samech, /s/, is pronounced identically to Shin, indicating a link with the mind. The second letter of Samech, /m/, relates to the body, (i.e., matter). Finally, the third letter of Samech, /ch/, relates to transformation and rebirth. Synthesizing these concepts, at least one possible interpretation is **transformation of the mind through victory over temptation in the body**. Here again, we see a strong relationship between the phonetics (sound) and semantics (meaning) of the AH letter Samech.

GS of Ayin: 10th Single Letter and 16th sequential letter of the AB; one of only two silent letters in the entire AB, the other being Aleph. Silent letters are an admonition to always remember that the ineffable nature of God or Spirit can never be completely captured on the physical plane; the word "Ayin" means eye, but combining this with its inner plane relationship, it refers not to physical sight, but to inner sight, or perception; the Sages remind us that while we may not be able to control all the events of our lives, we can always control our responses to those our events. This gives perception an extraordinarily exalted status in our lives.

PS of Ayin: A guttural consonant produced at the 1st articulatory position. The word "Ayin" is composed of three letters: /a/, / y/, and /n/. The first letter, /a/, is a guttural produced deep in the throat, indicative of its inner, spiritual foundation. The second letter, /y/ is a palatal produced slightly more forward in the mouth. The third letter, /n/, is a lingual produced in the center of the oral cavity. Thus, we see in the construction of the word "Ayin" a process of unfolding from spiritual to mental. Notice that none of the letters move more forward than the middle of the mouth, clearly demonstrating that the symbolism of this letter relates to the spiritual and mental planes, but not as directly to the physical plane.

GS of Tzade: 11th Single Letter and 18th sequential letter of AB; symbolic of spiritual completion and righteousness.

PS of Tzade: A dental consonant produced at the 4th articulatory position. The first letter of Tzade, /tz/, is a composite sound make up of two distinct phones, /t/ and /z/. /t/ relates to Tayt, the ninth sequential letter of the AB, as well as Taw, the 22nd and final sequential letter of the AB. As such, it represents a state of climax, completion, and closure. The second phone, /z/ relates to the 7th sequential letter, Zayin. Through its association with the Heptad, this letter is closely associated with spirituality and Godliness. Recall that the heptagon is the only regular polygon which cannot be exactly circumscribed within a circle, and as such reminds us that while spirit can be approximated by matter, it can never be fully exemplified. Taken together, /tz/ can be interpreted as **spiritual completion**, a clear hallmark of the Tzadik, or righteous one.

ק	Quph	Back of the head	19/100/3-12	Single	Palatal	Pisces
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GS of Quph: 12th Single Letter and 19th sequential letter of the AB; Begins such AH words as **kedushah** (holiness), **karban** (sacrifice), and **kabbalah** (to receive). Based on its Gematria $(100 \rightarrow 1 + 0 + 0 = 1; 19 \rightarrow 1 + 9 = 10 \rightarrow 1 + 0 = 1)$, closely associated with Monad, and therefore God, Spirit, and Unity. Based on phonosemantic analysis explained below, can be interpreted as **holiness in thought, word, and deed**.

PS of Quph: A palatal consonant produced at the 2nd articulatory position. The first letter of Quph, /k/ relates to holiness and the spiritual plane, as explained above. The second letter of Quph, /w/, is a labial consonant that relates to the physical plane. Finally, the third letter of Quph, /ph/ relates to the unique capacity for human speech, the production of which stands in as a metaphor for all creative acts, including God's construction of the universe through the formation of discrete ideas and, representatively, the words that we use to express them.



The Distant Past - Ten of Cups, - "a decidedly unconventional affectional interest; its inner interpretation is EMOTION."

The Recent Past - Arcanum XXI - The Adept (reversed) - "Success or Attainment."

The Present - The Nine of Swords (reversed) - "a quarrel resulting in enmity; its inner interpretation is RENUNCIATION."

The Near Future - Six of Cups - "a love affair; its inner interpretation is ATTAINMENT."

The Distant Future - Arcanum VIII - The Balance (reversed) - "Justice or Equilibrium."

Interpretation

The Distant Past - Ten of Cups. The Querent has a powerful emotional attachment to his home. It is the longest he has lived at any location in his life.

The Recent Past - Arcanum XXI (reversed). The home receives a lot of praise or recognition by individuals and realtors who have visited it.

The Present - The Nine of Swords (reversed). The Querent is having difficulty leaving the home and doesn't what to rent it to "just anybody."

The Near Future - Six of Cups. Someone will fall in love with the home and garden and the Querent will be able to achieve his goal.

The Distant Future - Arcanum VIII. The Querent will end up with a reliable tenant, perhaps not in a timely fashion.

Summary

The Yes or No spread is comprised of five cards laid out from left to right. Cards I and 2 represent the past of the matter, the center card represents the present, and cards 4 and 5 symbolize the future. Right-side-up cards represent a yes answer, and reversed cards no. Each card is worth the value of one point for yes or no, with the exception of the center card, which has the value of two points.

In this spread, three of the cards (2nd, 3rd and 5th) were reversed, indicating a "no" answer. Two of the cards in this spread are Cups which represent the strong emotions attached to the home. Two of the cards are Major Arcanum which indicates the importance of the subject, yet they are both reversed which weakens their power. No doubt the Querent will be able to find a tenant, perhaps just not a "perfect" tenant, or perhaps not in the time frame he hopes for.
