## THE NIGHT SKY-3RD QUARTER 2012

Mercury: one of the fainter of the planets, Mercury can be viewed at the beginning of July after sunset on the western horizon. On the evening of the 19th and 20th, the crescent of the New Moon can be seen in conjunction with Mercury in the west at sundown. On August 15th and 16th, early-riser will be treated to a conjunction of the Crescent Moon with Mercury just before sunrise.

Venus: the second-brightest object in the night skies after the Moon, Venus will be viewed as a morning star throughout the 3rd Quarter of the year. At the beginning of July, Venus can be seen before sunrise in conjunction with Jupiter. Over the next 90 days they will move 70 degrees apart from one another. Look to the eastern horizon just before sunrise July 14th—16th to view the waxing

Moon in Conjunction with Venus and Jupiter. There will be an occultation of Venus by the Moon on August 13, visible from parts of Japan, China, and Russia. From the US the Moon-Venus Conjunction can be seen in the predawn hours on August 13th and 14th, and again on September 12th and 13th.

Mars: the red planet looms in the western skies after sunset throughout the 3rd Quarter of the year. On the evenings of July 23rd—25th, the Moon will be in conjunction with Mars and Saturn as she nears First Quarter. Throughout August, Mars and Saturn will be in conjunction. The Moon will conjunct Saturn and Mars August 20th—22nd, and again September 17th—19th.

**Jupiter:** remains bright in the early morning skies throughout the 3rd Quarter of the year.

Each day he will be moving further away from Venus with whom he shares the eastern horizon at the start of July. The Moon conjuncts Jupiter July 14th—15th, August 11th and 12th, and again September 7th and 8th.

**Saturn:** At the start of the 3rd Quarter Saturn is 102 degrees away from the Sun and is visible on the zenith at sunset. Over the next 90 days the Sun draws closer to Saturn so that by the end of the 3rd Quarter Saturn and the Sun are separated by only 21 degrees of longitude. This means that at sunset of September 30th, Saturn can be seen hanging low, just above the western horizon in proximity to Mercury. Saturn can be seen in conjunction with the Moon on July 24th—25th, August 20th— 21st, and September 17th-18th.

### FALL CLASS: DELINEATION WITH ASTRODYNES

Astro means star and Dyna means power. Astrodynes (aka cosmodynes) are a method of determining the amount of power, harmony, and discord in any chart. Astrodynes are the result of independent research conducted by Church of Light students around the world during the 1930's and 40's. The research results were sent to Church of Light headquarters where they were tested and codified into the system that we use today.

Astrodynes not only quantify the power of each of the planets, signs, houses, and aspects in a chart, but also reveal the percentage of that power in relationship to the whole of the chart. Areas of personal power express as our most prominent characteristics or personality traits, and also correlate to the areas of life in which the individual feels most naturally impelled. In this six-week course the participant will learn how to read an astrodyne report, and apply the technique in refining his or her delineation skills. Each class we will look at sample charts of celebrities and other notables. The student will have the opportunity to analyze the astrodynes of their own chart in order to identify the key patterns in their own consciousness.

For students outside of Albuquerque, these classes will be online live at Church of Light TV, then archived the following week for viewing.
