THE NIGHT SKY- 2ND QUARTER 2013

Mercury: one of the fainter of the planets, Mercury can be viewed as a morning star in April. In the predawn hours of April 7th and 8th he can be viewed on the eastern horizon with the waning crescent Moon. By June Mercury will be an evening star. The waxing crescent Moon can be viewed on the western horizon at sunset of June 10th in conjunction with Mercury and Venus.

Venus: the second-brightest object in the night skies after the Moon, Venus will be an evening star throughout the 2nd Quarter of the year. In the first week of April she will be too close to the Sun to be visible at sunset. From mid-may through mid June there will be a beautiful conjunction of Mercury, Venus and Jupiter on the western horizon at sunset.

Mars: the red planet can be

seen hanging low in the western horizon at sunset at the beginning of 2nd Quarter of 2013. By Aril 17th he conjuncts the Sun and will spend the remainder of the Quarter as a morning star. Look to the eastern horizon just before sunrise on May 8th—9th, and again on June 7th—8th to see the waning crescent Moon in conjunction with Mars.

Jupiter: the third brightest object in the heavens will be an evening star until mid-June when he conjuncts the Sun. By the end of the 2nd Quarter Jupiter can be viewed just before sunrise alongside Mars on the eastern horizon. On the evening of April 13th—14th, May 11th—12th,and again on June 8th—9th the waxing lunar crescent can be viewed in conjunction with Jupiter on the western horizon. **Saturn:** will be visible in conjunction with the Full Moon just after sunset on April 25th. The waxing Moon will conjunct Saturn again on May 23rd and June 19th.

Meteor Showers: The radiant for the Lyrid meteor shower, April's "shooting stars," is in the constellation Lyra, which rises in the northeast at about 10 p.m. About 10-100 meteors per hour at peak can be expected. The waxing gibbous Moon will be bright, so watch this meteor shower after moonset and before dawn on April 22.

The Eta-Aquarids are a meteor shower associated with Haley's Comet, and appear to radiate from the constellation Aquarius. The most meteors can be seen in the east-southeast in the dark hours before dawn on May 5.


