

The Sacred Hebrew Alphabet Dalet: Born into Being

☆

Scenza

The fourth letter of the Hebrew Alefbayt (AB) is Dalet, which translates as "door". It is indeed a door, if not perhaps the door through which all manifestation occurs. The number 4 is of incredible value and import in ancient Sacred Geometry (for a much deeper elaboration, please see my article on the Tetrad). This same import is repeated and emphasized in Kabbalistic

literature as well. The Kabbalists refer to the Four Worlds, through which all existence is made possible. The first world is Azilut, or Emanation. This is the spiritual level where an idea is first conceived. The second world is Beriah, or Creation. This is the level at which a mental picture of the idea is formed. The third world, Yetzirah, or Formation, represents the commitment of

energy and emotion to the undertaking. Finally, in the fourth step that desire is brought into being, through the world of Assiyah, or Action. This last world represents the manifestation of the goal in reality.

It is not at all accidental that we in the Brotherhood of Light apply the same conception, though we use the sym-

The Eighth House: Death's Doorstep

In the past three weeks, two of my dear friends have crossed the River Styx. I believe I have mentioned before in these articles that as I approach each one, the lessons of the houses come rallying to my attention. I admit that as I approached my research and musings in preparation for this installment, that I was hoping for a transformative event, a financial windfall, an offer of a fantastic all-expenses-paid voyage to an exotic location, perhaps even simply a refund on my taxes, or a romantic night to remember. Instead, my friends died.

The eighth house is the house of surrender. Usually our first definition of the eighth

house is "sex, death, and other peoples' money," which is simplistic, but easy for most of us to remember as beginners. On further investigation, which we must make to become proficient astrologers, we come to understand that the eighth house demands that we let go, surrender, transform, and make an end to all that is holding us back from the life of Spirit. There are times when life is bittersweet; the qualities of sadness and joy become inextricably intertwined with one another. This is one of those times for many of us who work at the Church of Light. Our President, Paul Brewer, recently announced that he would not be available for re-election to the board of directors. When his term expires this June – he is retiring. We are sad to see him go, and joyful that he will have the opportunity to travel more, spend time with his grandchildren, and to enjoy life. We are also grateful for his many years of service to The Church of Light.

Paul first joined the Church in the summer of 1969 and became more active at headquarters in 1975 when he, his wife Vicki, and their infant daughter, Emily, moved from Oklahoma to Los Angeles. A decade later, in 1985, when the Church was under legal assault from a small group of members, Paul and Vicki courageously came forward and were elected to the board as others stepped down from leadership. It is thirty years now that I have had the privilege of working alongside Paul on the board of directors.

When I retired from the presidency in 1994 and became an honorary board member for life, Paul was elected to be the next president. It is amazing to think that he has served as president for 21 years, for this is longer than Elbert Benjamine was president of The Church of Light.

During his lengthy tenure as president, Paul has guided our organization into the age of computers and technology. When I look back almost 40 years, to when I started working in the print rooms at The Church of Light, we were using card catalogs, typewriters and offset printing presses. Times have changed, and in the last 20 years our accounting systems, membership databases, publishing programs, telephones and answering systems have all shifted to computer-based technologies.


Our bookstore, services, classes and so much more are available to seekers around the world who have access to the internet. We now have a virtual community of Stellarians.

It was also during Paul's tenure that an endowment fund was established in which the principle will exist in perpetuity, and the annual interest earned provides an income for the Church. Several key members have generously donated to this fund, and Paul leaves the Church in better financial shape than the organization he inherited.

Paul is the designer of the Horoscope © program, a computer software that calculates natal charts, astrodynes, progressions and progressed astrodynes. This is a process which in previous eras would have required more than 40 hours of hand calculations per chart. As a result of Paul's Brewer's ingenuity and persistence, Hermetic Astrologers can now have all the calculations they need in minutes. As a result of Paul's technological know-how and visionary leadership of

obsessions, compulsions; which are also a part of what is defined in the eighth. The lessons of the eighth involve recognizing these as they become a detriment to our spiritual growth and then finding the fortitude to release these attachments in the name of transformation.

In past articles we have discussed archetypes and the shadow material which we must embrace in order to transform. Each house of the horoscope gives rise to opportunities for us to practice alchemical transmutation of the energies therein represented by the signs of the zodiac and the planets in their various combinations. The shadow material is in each house, but in the 8th house we find those inherited tendencies, the legacies of dysfunction which are hardest to acknowledge and transform. In the 8th house we find our deepest desires, our mysteries of sex and intimacy and how we express them. bolism of the four elements. The same scheme is followed, but the elements are substituted for the various worlds. In this system, Fire represents the first world, Air the second, Water the third, and Earth the fourth. Indeed, these are deep and memorable teachings, lodging themselves deep in the consciousness of the learner.

And again, we see the same exact motif expressed arithmetically in the simple yet profound equation: I + 2 + 3 + 4 = 10. In this seemingly inane formula, the same principle of a four-stage manifestation is revealed. It takes no

less than four discrete stages to complete a cycle (represented by the Decad). This single equation may well form the basis for our entire system of mathematics, but this topic has already been covered at length in my articles on the Tetrad and Decad.

Finally, we observe the same formula geometrically in the famed Tetrakys of Pythagoras, an ancient visual representation of the inextricable link between 4 and 10 (shown below).

The Tetrakys is at once four (serially) and ten (cumulatively). It demonstrates pictographically the enduring link between the Tetrad as


a symbol of an idea brought into being in four discrete stages, and the Decad as the symbol of the completion of a cycle of manifestation.

Linguistically, Dalet is classified by the ancient Kabbalists as a lingual, indicating that it is formed with the tongue. According to modern linguistic theory, it is classified as a voiced alveolar stop, which rather describes the placement of the tongue just behind the teeth at a portion of the mouth called the alveolar ridge. From my own observations and investigations, I believe that the tongue, in

making the sound /d/ moves downward, deepening, darkening tone, and perhaps even dying to its former high place. Whether through its motion or its association with the planet Mars, it begins the words for death, destruction, disease, damage, and a whole host of other words which indicate dismay. Dr. Margaret Magnus has performed extensive research on the relationship between sound and meaning in the English language, and many of my thoughts are authenticated by her work.

Hence, we have here a letter which simultaneously represents death and life, the end and a new beginning. For

some, this might seem paradoxical, but if one is familiar with the concepts promulgated by the Ancients, then it could *only* be this way, as for them, as for so many of us now, every ending is a new beginning, every death a presage to a new life.

SCORPIO: Middle height, thick set, corpulent, hooked nose, dark hair, ruddy or swarthy complexion.

Interpretive Notes

The Court Arcana generally represent the 12 personality types associated with the 12 signs of the zodiac. However, this correspondence does not necessarily refer to the sun-sign, so the reader should focus on describing the personality and appearance based on zodiacal symbolism. The Kings and Youths, when upright, are interpreted as a masculine influence governed by each sign; when reversed, feminine. The Queens, when upright, represent women; when reversed, men.

In the Hermetic System, the tarot represents a synthesis of the universe, based on astrological symbolism; the court arcana can also represent the 12 houses in a horoscope. The Queen of Cups, Scorpio, corresponds to the Eighth House of death, the spirit world, unseen entities, other people's money, taxes, inheritances, gifts, grants and legacies.

The Past — Ace of Coins "The divinatory significance of the Ace of Coins is a short journey; its inner significance is POLICY."

The Present – Horseman of Cups "The Horseman of Cups denotes thoughts of love or affection. Right way up they are sincere and to the client's advantage; reversed they indicate deceit or opposition to the true affectional desires."

The Future — Seven of Cups (reversed) "The divinatory significance of the Seven of Cups is a successful change of home; its inner interpretation is VERITY."

The Ability to Control — Six of Coins (reversed) "The divinatory significance of the Six of Coins is a social event; its inner interpretation is REPRESSION."


The Environment — Ten of Cups (reversed) "The divinatory significance of the Ten of Cups is a decidedly unconventional affectional interest; its inner interpretation is EMOTION."

The Opposition — Nine of Cups (reversed) "The divinatory significance of the Nine of Cups is that the hopes will be realized; it is the WISH-CARD; its inner interpretation is VICISSITUDES."

The Outcome — Ace of Cups "The divinatory significance of the Ace of Cups is a letter from a loved one; its inner interpretation is MOODS."

The Environment, is dominated by the Ten of Cups (reversed), shows that there may be some emotional ups and downs that come from interacting with the public, however he will find an unusual love for the work.

The Opposition is symbolized by Nine of Cups (reversed), a card which normally indicates that one's wishes will be realized. In the opposition this might show that the Querent's expectations may not be completely realized.

The Outcome, as revealed by the Ace of Cups affirms that he will ultimately love his work, and in turn be loved by his participants and coworkers.

Celebrating 100 Years of Brotherhood of Light Classes May 1915-May 2015

May 1915-May 2015: Celebrating 100 Years of Brotherhood of Light Classes

hen Elbert Benjamine gave his promise to bring The Brotherhood of Light teachings to Earth in 1910 there had never been an organized attempt to teach the teachings. Thomas Burgoyne's The Light of Egypt was a text-book of sorts, which students could study privately, but The Brotherhood of Light's astrological and other teachings weren't available in a format that permitted class room teaching. It was a problem that Elbert immediately addressed in 1914 with the writing of Course 8 and Course 10 and when he arrived in Los Angeles in May 1915 he commenced teaching The Hermetic System of Astrology on a Monday night to astrology students and a private psychic development class that was not opened to the public. It was a history making moment; for the first time, The Brotherhood of Light teachings were being taught in a classroom setting.

☆☆☆

In November, 1928, Elbert explained: 'Since that time I have taught these weekly astrological classes continuously, with the exception of some two months during the war when I taught weekly classes elsewhere.' And he continued to teach his weekly classes till mid 1949 when his evangelical work saw him take The Brotherhood of Light's message 'to any group that was interested in learning about inner-plane facts.'

On November 11, 1918, Elbert held the first Brotherhood of Light Convention and opened the psychic development class to the public. Fred H Skinner, the Church of Light's first vice-president, and Elizabeth Dorris were soon attending the class and, in the autumn of 1919, Fred began teaching for The Brotherhood of Light. He taught students how to construct their birthcharts and, from then until his passing in 1940, he was the Brotherhood's principle astrology teacher. Elbert Benjamine acknowledged him as 'The Dean of Astrology."

In February 1919 Lenora Conwell, who later became Elbert's working partner at The Brotherhood of Light Astrological Research Department, joined his Monday night astrology class and in 1920 she opened the Hollywood Church of Light Center and commenced teaching astrology classes. And with teachers teaching the Hermetic system of astrology from student friendly textbooks it wasn't long before the astrological community in America became aware of the wonderful personal benefits of Elbert Benjamine's glorious system of astrology. By 1934, Church of Light Centers were teaching astrology classes throughout America. At Church of Light Headquarters in Los Angeles nine teachers were teaching classes on every day of the week except Sunday. And in Canada classes were being conducted by Cliff Barkley, Sue Starnaman and Henry W. Bowers at four Church of Light Centers.

On January 31, 1938 in Wichita, Kansas, Mildred Schuler published the first issue of The Rising Star, a monthly magazine devoted to teaching The Hermetic System of Astrology. And The Rising Star, which became the official organ for teaching students who did not have access to classroom learning, became a powerful resource for explaining the teachings and principles of Hermetic astrology. Mildred conducted a monthly feature on natal astrology explaining how to construct and interpret a natal chart. And The Rising Star presented and explained The Hermetic system of astrology to astrology students throughout America.

By 1950, Elbert had presented the science of Hermetic astrology, Church of Light teachers were teaching the science, and the Hermetic System of Astrology had become the most popular and widely used system of astrology in America.

Following Elbert's departure to inner-plane work in November 1951, classes continued in Los Angeles under the direction of Ed and Doris Doane and throughout America at established Church of Light Centers, but the loss of the Church's dynamic leader was a difficult blow and without his push and enthusiasm the momentum to teach, prac-

tice and disseminate the Religion of the Stars slow-ly waned. But it is safe to say that at no stage did the teaching of Hermetic astrology cease.

Ed and Doris Doane continued in their leadership of the Church of Light from 1951 through 1967. The 1960's and 70's were a period of an "occult revival" in the United States and elsewhere as the younger generation sought to cast off the mantle of orthodoxy and

explore pre-Christian spiritual traditions. During the '50's and '60's, Ed and Doris were living "up on the hill" at the Coral Street address that had originally been the home of Elizabeth and Elbert Benjamine. Behind the house, the Doane's built a wood frame and metal-siding warehouse to store the vast inventory of B of L Lessons that were being printed. Classes were held at The Church of Light offices and storefront on 6th Street in Los Angeles near Western Boulevard. In addition to teaching classes at The Church of Light, Doris and Ed also taught Hermetic Astrology through Katalin B. Williams' Foundation for Scientific Spiritual Understanding (FOSSU) in Redondo Beach, California. Some of the other top-names teaching Brotherhood of Light courses during the late '60's and early '70's, at FOSSU, were King Keyes, JoAnne Poole, Lois Rodden and Mary Sample.

By the end of 1967, Ed Doane's health was failing, and on January 8, 1968, Vena S. Naughton replaced him as president. Naughton's eight-year tenure as president coincided with an era in which there was widespread interest in The Brotherhood of Light Lessons. During this time The Church of Light made an ambitious move from the 6th Street storefront into more spacious accommodations three blocks away on St. Andrews Place and Wilshire Boulevard. Many Church of Light members who were part of the local organization during these years fondly

remember the St. Andrews Place property, which contained a large auditorium with stage that functioned as both classroom and chapel. The facility also contained a bookstore, library, offices, kitchen and print room. President Vena Naughton was an active teacher, and in September, 1970, she applied for copyright for a Teachers Manual for Beginner's Astrological Delineation. Although

The Church of Light was granted a copyright, the manual was never formally published, just distributed internally.

Ken Stone was elected president in 1976. In an optimistic move Church expanded into additional offices and opened a well-appointed metaphysical bookstore called The Light of Egypt, when a Wilshire Boulevard storefront in the St. Andrews complex came available. During the meta-

physical heyday of the '70's four classes-a-week were being taught in the auditorium, on weekday evenings and Saturdays. During much of the '70's, the most popular course was Jesse Montoya's Tarot class, and Saturday afternoons would often see a packed auditorium of eager students. Other classes being taught during the late 70's ran the gamut from Beginning Chart Erection to Hermetic Progressions. The exciting roster of C. of L. trained instructors included, but was not limited to: Karl Berger, Paul Brewer, Larraine Crost, Carleton Guellow, Wendall B. Haas, Maurice and Danielle LeCroy, Linden and Holly Leisge, Jesse Montoya, Marguerite Morin, Carol Peel, Phyllis Stanick, Ken Stone, and Forrest and Meg Teague.

1978 ushered in a time of transitions and adaptations for The Church of Light. The bubble burst on the market for occult and astrology books and The Church of Light, now financially over-extended, with leases on the auditorium, bookstore and offices, was faced with difficult choices. The Church leadership decided to let go of the Light of Egypt bookstore and auditorium and withdrew to an inner courtyard suite of offices with the print shop and a smaller inventory of books.

During the last two years of his life, Jesse Montoya mentored a group of students in a class called "The Academy." The Academy was limited to a set number of advanced Church of Light students who convened on Thursday evenings in the courtyard office on St. Andrews Place. Jesse privately taught a syncretism of Brotherhood of Light Psychic Development, Mexican "Curandismo," and the "Los Misterios" traditions of the Dominican Republic. Although considered controversial by some, the majority of Academy members felt that they had re-

ceived a very important education.

During 1978, Forrest Teague and Owen Mansfield opened a bookstore called Fantasy Meets Reality, in Santa Monica, California, and for the next couple of years Church Light classes were taught out of the classroom in the rear of the bookstore. That same year was also when star instructor, Jesse Montoya, began a rapid

decline due to a struggle with diabetes. Shortly before his demise in May, 1978, Jesse requested that Christopher Gibson replace him as tarot instructor.

In 1979, Vance Sargent held the position of president for a one-year period. The following year, in 1980, Linden Leisge commenced his four-year tenure as president. During Linden's presidency, Church of Light Headquarters moved away from Los Angeles to an office building in Sunland, California. Around 1986, Headquarters returned to the Coral St. property, just east of Downtown Los Angeles, where it was housed through 1999. Neither Sunland nor Coral Street were conducive to attracting students. Commencing in 1980, Wendy Banks and Christopher Gibson began teaching Church of Light classes in Hermetic astrology and Egyptian Tarot through the Community Services program at Los Angeles City College and West Los Angeles College as a means of opening up the B of L teachings to a wider public audience. Christopher continued teaching two to four classes a week at LACC until 1996. The former Church of Light auditorium was

now home to the Thomas Institute of Metaphysics where Christopher also taught Hermetic Astrology and Egyptian Tarot classes for several years as a means of keeping the attention of occult students already accustomed to that location for Church of Light classes.

In Sydney, Australia, in February 1984, Dennis Sutton began teaching Hermetic astrology and astrodynes to a class at the Sydney Astrological Research Society. For three years he was active teaching three astrology classes using textbooks he wrote and published. Later, in 1995 he

was involved in a grand venture - the establishment of the Academy of Hermetic Astrology in Canberra, Australia, with Iulia Goldstein. The Academy provided a three-year course that taught students how to assess their birthcharts and progressed charts. At the height of its success the academy had over 30 students with a new course semester starting each year, but in the end the grand adven-

ture was short-lived due to an inability to attract new students.

Back in Los Angeles, Lea Riffle was president from 1984 until his death in November 1991. During these years and through the end of the 1990's all of the Church of Light resources were being dedicated to the International organization and keeping the B of L lessons in print. Members were still active passing exams, but the only classes being held publicly were through Los Angeles City College.

Vicki Brewer served as interim-president from December 1991 – May 1992, when Christopher Gibson was elected President. Paul Brewer was elected president in 1994 and has served until the present time. In 1999, the Church of Light moved away from the Benjamine property on Coral St. and relocated to new offices in Brea, California, near the home of Paul and Vicki Brewer. In Brea, President

Wendy Banks was born in London, England, and is best known as the Astrological Editor for Starscrolls, a monthly astrological calendar, for whom she developed a I-900 phone line. Wendy holds a degree in education from London University. In addition to her astrological practice, Wendy has a diverse profes-

sional background including stints as a teacher, legal secretary, real estate agent, theatre professional, a script supervisor for film and television; she currently works as a certified yoga instructor escorting students on yoga retreats around the world.

A recent Hermetician, Wendy began her Church of Light studies in 1976. She passed the professional level exam of the American Federation of Astrologers in 1981. A lively and inspiring teacher, Wendy taught astrology at The Church of Light in 1979 and through the College Community Services program at L.A. City College and West L.A. during the 1980's. gression report in order to determine upcoming life trends. The participant will evaluate his or her chart from the perspective of what patterns in consciousness might be stimulated under particular progressed aspects. Special attention will be placed on applying mental antidotes to harmonize discordant planets and aspects in order to attract desirable events and activities into one's life. 
