The Sacred Hebrew Alphabet: Bayt: Bursting into Being

Scenza

The first letter of the Alefbayt (AB) is Aleph. Yet, the first letter of the Torah, the sacred book of the Kabbalists, is Bayt. Why might this be so? Many explanations have been offered, all wonderful and complimentary. One of my favorites is that Aleph represents the immaterial Spirit of God, while Bayt, as the second letter of the AB, represents the process of birth, of bursting

forth into being which is accomplished by even the very first stroke of the Torah. Taken another way, here again we are admonished to always bear in mind that the presence and spirit of God was, is, and always will be supernal and undefinable. In the same way that the prohibition against creating idols reminds us that God is in its essence, beyond male, female, white, black, or

any other single descriptor, beginning with Bayt rather than Aleph reminds us of the infinite, immeasurable nature of the Supreme Being.

The Hebrew word Bayt means "house". This keyword hints at one of its many meanings. A house is the warm, protective, nurturing environment in which a father and mother seek to



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Editorial

This issue of the Quarterly features the Sixth House of work, health and service. When we think of the word service we think of the performance of any helpful act. Professionals offer their services for profit, and volunteers offer their services as a charitable act. To survive in this modern world without a trust fund, inheritance or estate, one exchanges either goods or services for money.

Under the feudal system, serfs were bound legally, socially and economically to the landed gentry. In the period following the Renaissance and the rise of Humanism, the feudal system and its many abuses were slowly dismantled in Western Europe. Eastern Europe and Russia were slower to reform and serfdom was not abolished in these regions until the mid-19th century. Tibet and Bhutan did not abandon serfdom until the mid-20th century. The aristocratic estates of Western Europe still needed workers, and the poorer classes sought positions of "service" in the great homes. There they were known as servants, a term of subservience that has fallen into general disuse.

In our self-important, individualism-driven culture, the words service, servant and servitude are an anathema to us. This is because serf, service, servant and servitude have evolved etymologically from the Latin servus, meaning slave. None of us wants to be a slave, none of us wants to be deprived of our basic human rights.


However, from the spiritual perspective, we can only grow in love and wisdom when we are of service to others. Therefore, we must train ourselves to be servants, to be of service. Throughout the 23 books of The Brotherhood of Light Lessons, C. C. Zain extols us to render "constructive service," "greater service," "helpful service," "maximum service," and "valuable service" to humanity. The Brotherhood of Light emphasizes this in its universal moral code: "Contribute Your Utmost to Universal Welfare."

When studying an astrological chart the Sixth House can hold insightful keys as to how and where we can be of service to others. The planets in the Sixth House, as well as the sign on the Sixth House cusp and its ruling planets should be taken into consideration when evaluating how one can best be of service. Every community has outlets both secular and religious where the individual can choose to donate his or her time for the betterment of society.

In <u>Occultism Applied</u>, C. C. Zain summarized the chapter on "How to be Happy" with the following statement: "The individual who has found the line of endeavor in which he can render greatest service to humanity, who has learned how to find pleasure in all that he does, who makes effort to refine his body, intellect and feelings, and who has taken the pains to find harmonious channels of expression for all his insistent desires, is one of the happiest people in the world."

"The Sixth House belongs to the trinity of wealth. It is a cadent house; consequently transmits energy very weakly." The wealth here we are considering is the spiritual gold of experience. Knowledge is Power. We acquire our wealth through our experiences, and the Sixth House wealth comes from the daily grind of working for experience. As a cadent house below the horizon and on the west side of the chart, it is secretive and has little chance of growth, so arguably the sixth house may be the weakest house in the chart.

"It influences **broadly** those things that assist or hinder the acquisition of wealth, such as assimilation, illness, labor, inferiors, and servants." The physical/Spiritual body itself is the First House, but what goes on in the Sixth House are the mundane events which govern how we are helped or hindered in our work toward building our spiritual bodies. We all know that when our bodies (physical or spiritual) are not functioning properly, there is a huge obstacle to the acquisition of wealth, that spiritual gold we seek. As I consider those people who have chronic illness and yet use that dis-ease as a means toward enlightenment, I am humbled and filled with awe. We have so many examples in our world today of these shining souls

Our individual charts allow us the insight we need to use our knowledge to engage the Sixth House in our quest. Just because the Sixth is hindered in its expression, does not mean that we should neglect to use its full potential in our work. It is the work. It describes completely to us how we may do the work and what, when, and how the work may be done and the wealth of energy accumulated. Look at the horoscope. See the planets occupying, the house ruler and ask: "What can these stellar influences bring to my Spiritual growth?" Check the astrodynes and progressions to our horoscope and ask: "When are the best times for me to work harder? When do I need to protect myself from discord and dis-ease?" Use our knowledge of Astrology, Tarot, and Alchemy to ask: "How can I best use my own life to improve my quest for Spirit?"

The Sixth House truly has a wealth of overlooked information for us in our search for the life of Spirit. I have learned in the course of my illness that while I

raise and nourish their young. Similarly, the universe is the house, or the physical location, in which God seeks to raise and nourish us, his (or her) offspring. Hence, Bayt, in a sense similar to Mem, represents the physical or material world through which Spirit (as represented by Aleph) seeks to express itself, to develop and grow.

From a linguistic point of view, it is not at all surprising

that parallels can be drawn between Mem and Bayt. Mem is the second mother letter, while Bayt is the second letter of the AB. Both letters are classified in the same category, namely as bilabial consonants, meaning that in order to sound them. the airstream must be completely blocked by pursing the lips and then allowing it to burst forth past the barrier of the lips, giving birth to the formation of a barrage of sound. Perhaps I am being a bit poetic, but I hope the point will be made. Indeed, Magnus (2000) has completed a thorough and fascinating analysis of the phonemes in English, and has demonstrated compelling evidence that

the relationship between sound and meaning is anything but random. That is, whether unconsciously or consciously, it appears that people associate certain sounds with certain meanings. Forceful, bursting phonemes, such as /b/, are used with far greater frequency in words that symbolize breaking through, breezing about, or some other sudden, forceful event. It is as if the language is attempting to capture the meaning of the word through a linguistic approximation of its value. Softer, subtler sounds such as /s/ are used to describe smooth, sweet, or even sultry things. Unfortunately for our studies, Magnus chose to perform her research in English rather than Biblical Hebrew. It would indeed be a thoroughly interesting study to see if such similarities of sound symbolism also exist across tongues.

Rabbi Munk provides a thoroughly illuminating description of each of the Hebrew letters in his text *The Wisdom in the Hebrew Alphabet* (1983) which is built upon his lifetime of research and investigation into the Hebrew cul-

ture and language. My efforts here can only pale in comparison to such an eminent mind focused for so long on such an engaging topic. However, a recurrent theme in Rabbi Munk's analysis of the letter Bayt is the principle of Duality. It is quite apparent where this link might come from, as Bayt is the second letter of the AB, and even as it is a bilabial consonant. Munk sees in the duality of Bayt a chance to reconcile the opposites upon which the world is built. In the Judeo-Christian conception, God

begins as a Transcendent Unity which, in its desire to create the world, must then divide into Duality. This creates the World of Opposites: Light and Dark, White and Black, Man and Woman. However, opposites always beget a state of separation and polarity. It is through the symbolism of the Trinity that the true principle of manifestation comes to bear: opposites in balance, creating a sustainable, healthful, harmonious circumstance which can support life. The Duality symbolized by Bayt is a critical step in this movement from Un-being to Being. It does not complete the quest, but without it, the quest

Interpretive Notes

The Court Arcana generally represent the 12 personality types associated with the 12 signs of the zodiac. However, this correspondence does not necessarily refer to the sun-sign, so the reader should focus on describing the personality and appearance based on zodiacal symbolism. The Kings and Youths, when upright, are interpreted as a masculine influence governed by each sign; when reversed, feminine. The Queens, when upright, represent women; when reversed, men.

In the Hermetic System, the tarot represents a synthesis of the universe, based on astrological symbolism; the court arcana can also represent the 12 houses in a horoscope. The Queen of Swords, Virgo, corresponds to the Sixth House of work, service, work-place, colleagues, coworkers, employees, tenants, diet, nutrition, food, illness, small pets.


The Past, pictured by the Nine of Swords (reversed) indicates the disappearance of the jet and all persons on board.

The Future, pictured by the Ace of Swords is not promising for discovering any survivors.


















The Ability to Control, is revealed through Arc. XX The Sarcophagus (reversed) could indicate the search efforts, longest and most expensive in history.

By mapping the reinforcements made to major progressions by minor progressions the student and professional astrologer are better equipped to predict the timing of events. Also included in this volume are Thought-Cell Treatments to help avoid accidents, heart trouble, nervous breakdowns and more.

may be weak and feel powerless, that there is a world of Spirit open for me in this dis-ease. I have learned that while I rest while my body searches for healing within the remedies provided, my soul has a golden opportunity to soar and search for healing light. On some days I feel hopeless and despondent, and coincidently I am unable to soar. As Above, so It Is Below.

The Sixth House is about routine: the routine of showing up every day to our labor; the routine of the environment of our labor; the routine of taking our medicine when we are ill, or to keep illness at bay; the routine of those with whom we labor; the routine of what we do each day and why and how we go about doing it. There is comfort in routine, which is why many people have such a difficult time with life changes which break the routines. In light of the knowledge that there are so many routines associated with the Sixth House, perhaps it will be advantageous for us to create routines in our spiritual life which we may fall upon during those times of life change.

One of the most beautiful routines that I trust is recitation and meditation on the mantra and prayers we use in the Church of Light, along with other prayers and practices of comfort. Most of us have these practices and prayers that we have learned along the way which we know are contributing to our growth in our life of

Spirit. These practices are very important. They support our spiritual life in the same ways as our supplements, remedies, and prescriptions support our physical life. The rituals and routines we practice help build life of Spirit, and thus they must be developed and nurtured in order for us to continue on our path.

As I write and contemplate what I am writing, I come back to where I started with words from The Church of Light Mantram (XXI,19-20), especially certain select phrases which apply so specifically to the Sixth House of the Spirit:

"...I am progressing rapidly toward the subjugation of matter and the complete lordship over all sub-mundane atoms of life, which exist...as peaceful and obedient servants....

"They exist by virtue of their functions in the work of creation, which I am now assisting; but they are and ever must be, subservient to the higher realms of Spirit to which I by right belong."

Come back to the Sixth House and all it has to teach us. Come back to the very basics of Spirit.




